PLEASE CONTINUE TO HELP SR. B.J.'s PANTRY!

We are continuing to support Sr. B.J.'s Pantry this school year. Families are asked to bring granola bars, fruit cups, beef jerky, Vienna sausage, small sized candy, bottled water, chewing gum, lunch-size bags of chips and pretzels, animal crackers, cookies, peanut butter, jelly, zip-lock bags, plastic spoons, travel-size toiletries and used paperback books. Sr. B.J.'s pantry distributes 500 breakfast bags per week to the homeless in downtown Oklahoma City. **Cash donations are accepted in the school office.** A collection box is in the school atrium. FRONT PARKING LOT DISMISSAL PROCEDURE **NOTE: There will be no diagonal parking in the dismissal area from 2:45 – 3:45. If you choose to park, please use the straight-in parking spaces around the perimeter of the lot.

1. Pull into the lot and proceed in single file to fill "lanes" like the drive-thru lanes at a bank.
2. Fill the lanes closest to the school first and pull up to the front of each lane as far as possible.
3. Students will be in the waiting area in front of the lanes. The teachers on duty will instruct the students to cross over and fill only the first car in each lane. No students or adults will be allowed between cars... so do not get out of your cars. Be ready to pull up when the front cars are instructed to leave the lot.
4. After the first cars in each lane are instructed to leave, all cars will pull forward in each lane. Once cars are stopped, the teachers on duty will instruct students to cross to the first cars.
5. When pulling forward to fill lanes, again, please fill the lanes closest to the school. If you stop to pull into the lanes closest to the street, it will block others cars behind you and the lanes closest to the school will be empty.
