PURPOSE: The purpose of the ASCS Science Fair is to provide students an opportunity to research and to study God's creations and mysteries.

PROJECT GUIDELINES:

1. Though students are expected to do as much of the work as possible, parental involvement is encouraged.
2. All students in Grades K - 8 are encouraged to participate.
3. Projects are to be free standing and presented on a tri-fold display board (available at craft and office supply stores).
4. Students are to follow the scientific method (except the K-1 educational display).
5. Judges reserve the right to combine or divide categories depending on participation levels.
6. No bodily fluids, poisons, or hazardous materials may be brought for exhibition.
7. No hazardous procedures or materials. No unethical or dangerous experiments.
8. No plant or animal used in a project may be brought for exhibition. Photographs only.
9. Approval by the ASCS Institutional Review Board must be given for all junior high projects utilizing human or animal subjects. Teacher approval is required for projects in other grade levels.
10. Divisions are: Kindergarten-Grade 1; Grades 2-3; Grades 4-5; Grades 6-8.
