LINCOLN BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

In Celebration of Abraham Lincoln's 200th birthday, All Saints is holding festivities next week. The week will culminate with a visit from Mr. Lincoln on Thursday at 9:30 a.m. during a school-wide assembly. We are partnering with First American Bank with a number of activities- a school-wide penny drive, the search for the oldest penny and a Gettysburg Address Contest. First American will match the first \$200 of pennies collected- with the proceeds benefiting All Saints. In addition, the student who brings in the oldest penny will be awarded a Savings Bond. Penny bins will be in each classroom. Students will count their pennies Wednesday afternoon to see which classroom collected the most.
